It was requested that a letter be sent to the appropriate authorities regarding the danger posed to traffic and pedestrians by the fencing and cones restricting an already narrow lane on a blind bend.

A query was raised regarding work on the willow tree at the War Memorial. The Clerk reported that progress has been delayed by the poor weather but the Contractor does plan to finish it soon.

It was suggested that the Cornish Mutual Competition for community project funding should be entered to try to win support for replacing the fencing around the War Memorial.
